Subject : Amendment in Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996.

In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Article 309 of the Constitution of India, the Governor of Rajasthan hereby makes the following rules further to amend the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996, namely :-

1. These rules may be called the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) (Amendment) Rules, 2009.
2. These rules shall come into force with immediate effect.
3. In the aforesaid rules - at the end of the existing Rule 76, a new Rule 76A shall be inserted by the following, namely: -

"76A. Grant of Ex-gratia Compensation to the polling personnel who sustain permanent disability while on Election duty.

The amount of ex-gratia grant, when a Government servant sustains permanent disability, like loss of limb, eye sight etc. in connection with election related duty shall be as follows: -

Kind of Mishap	Amount of ex-gratia grant
(i) Permanent disability like loss of limb, eye sight etc. in normal conditions while performing election related duty.	Rs.2.50 Lac
(ii) Permanent disability like loss of limb, eye sight etc. while performing election related duty, if caused by Extremist or unsocial elements.	Rs.5.00 Lac

Note:- A Government servant shall be treated on election duty as soon as he leaves his residence / office to report for any election related duty including training and until he reaches back his residence / office after performance of his election related duty. If any mishap takes place during this period, it should be treated as having occurred on election duty subject to condition that there should be a causal connection between occurrence of injury and the election duty."
