Sub :- Revision of pension of Pre- 01.09.2006 State Pensioners.


In the cases of State Government employees who have been permanently absorbed in Public Sector Undertakings / Autonomous Bodies and have drawn one time lump sum terminal benefit equal to 100% of their pension, in their cases 1/3rd of pension already restored has been revised vide FD Memorandum of even number dated 22.04.2010.

It has been represented to the Government that revision of one third commuted portion of pension under FD Memorandum of even number dated 22.04.2010 is resulting in drop in the total amount of one third restored pension plus Dearness Relief in comparison to total amount of the one third restored pension plus admissible Dearness Pay and Dearness Relief drawn by the pensioners.

Accordingly, the matter has been considered and the Governor is pleased to decide that such absorbees whose pre-revised one third restored pension plus admissible Dearness Pay and Dearness Relief as on 01.09.2008 works out to be more than the amount of revised one third restorable pension plus Dearness Relief admissible in accordance with the provisions of FD Memorandum of even number dated 22.04.2010 shall continue to draw the pre-revised pension plus Dearness Pay plus Dearness Relief admissible in terms of orders existed prior to issue of the FD Memorandum dated 22.04.2010 till such time the restored amount of revised pension in terms of instructions contained in FD Memorandum dated 22.04.2010 plus admissible Dearness Relief works out to be more than the pre-revised one third restored pension.

Necessary entries in the pension payment orders to this effect may be made accordingly.


