ORDER

No. F.12(4)FD(Rules)/2008

Jaipur, dated 4 MAR 2011

Subject: Grant of compensatory allowance equal to amount of Dearness Relief on family pension to probationer trainee who are in receipt of family pension.

The Government servants appointed as probationer trainee under Rajasthan Compassionate Appointment of Dependents of deceased Government Servants Rules, 1996 due to death of their spouse while in government service are not entitled to Dearness Relief on family pension as per provisions contained in Rule 77 of Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996 whereas before their appointment in government service they were in receipt of Dearness Relief on family pension under the aforesaid Rule 77.


Such government servants on appointment as probationer trainee are entitled to fixed remuneration during the probation period as per Schedule IV appended to Rule 21 of Rajasthan Civil Services (Revised Pay) Rules, 2008 but the Dearness Relief on family pension is discontinued. In some cases, it has been noticed that the fixed remuneration admissible to such probationer trainees is even less than the amount of Dearness Relief on family pension already admissible to them. This has resulted in anomalous situation which deserves rectification.

Accordingly, the matter has been considered and the Governor is pleased to order that Government Servants appointed/to be appointed due to death of their spouse while in service under the above referred rules and are in receipt of family pension may be allowed compensatory allowance equal to the amount of Dearness Relief admissible to them from time to time on family pension during the period of probation in addition to fixed remuneration.

The appointing authority of the concerned Government Servant shall be competent to grant this compensatory allowance to such probationer trainee upto completion of probation period satisfactorily and they are allowed pay in the prescribed running pay band and grade pay of the post.

This order shall come into force w.e.f. 01.03.2011.
