ORDER

Subject: Grant of Ex-gratia to the Family of Volunteer Home Guard who dies while on duty.

In accordance with the provisions contained in "Government of Rajasthan's Decision No. 2" appearing below Rule 75 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996, family of a Volunteer Home Guard who dies while on duty in the circumstances mentioned in clauses (b) to (e) of sub rule (1) is granted Ex-gratia grant of Rs. 10 lacs only subject to fulfillment of the conditions mentioned in sub rule (3) of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996.

The matter has been considered and the Governor is pleased to order that in the aforesaid cases the existing amount of Ex-gratia grant of Rs. 10 lacs is revised to Rs. 20 lacs.

The amount of Ex-gratia grant shall be granted by the Director General, Home Guard & Civil Defence to the widow / minor children of the deceased on receipt of application in the prescribed form except in the case of death while on Election duty. In the case of death of a Volunteer Home Guard while on Election duty, the amount of Ex-gratia grant shall be granted by the District Election Officer to the Family of a Volunteer Home Guard.

This order shall come into force w.e.f. 01.04.2012.
