MEMORANDUM

Sub :- Further revision of 1/3rd commuted portion of pension in respect of Government servants who had drawn lumpsum payment on absorption in Central Public Sector Undertakings / Central Autonomous Bodies - stepping up of notional full pension w.e.f. 01.07.2013.

Orders for revision of 1/3rd restored pension of absorbees, who had drawn lumpsum payment on absorption, were issued vide this Department Memorandum No. F. 12(3)FD/Rules/2008 dated 22.04.2010 as amended from time to time. As per para 'A' of the said Memorandum, the full pension of the absorbees was notionally revised w.e.f. 01.09.2006 in accordance with the instructions contained in this Department Memorandum No. F. 12(3)FD/Rules/2008 dated 12.09.2008. The payment of DR to old pensioners is regulated on the basis of the notional full pension.

2. Further orders have been issued vide this Department Memorandum No. F. 12(2)FD/Rules/2013 dated 18.06.2013 for stepping up of the pension of pre-2006 pensioners w.e.f. 01.07.2013. Accordingly, the notional full pension of the absorbee pensioners would also be stepped up w.e.f. 01.07.2013 in accordance with the instructions contained in the aforesaid Memorandum dated 18.06.2013. The pension so arrived at as indicated in Col. 8 of the Annexure of above Memorandum dated 18.06.2013 will be reduced pro-rata subject to a minimum of Rs. 3450/- p.m., where the pensioner had less than the maximum required service for full pension as per Rule 54 of the Rajasthan Civil Services (Pension) Rules, 1996, as applicable before 01.01.2006. The revised restored pension shall be 1/3rd of the pro-rata pension. The payment of Dearness Relief shall be allowed on the total of pro-rata pension and additional pension, if any.

3. In case the revised restorable 1/3rd pension calculated as per para 'B' of Memorandum dated 22.04.2010 is higher than the pension calculated in the manner indicated in para 2 above, the same will continue to be treated as basic pension.

4. All other conditions as given in Memorandum No. F. 12(3)FD/Rules/2008 dated 12.09.2008 as amended from time to time shall remain unchanged.

5. These orders will take effect from 01.07.2013. There will be no change in the amount of existing restored pension during the period from 01.01.2006 to 30.06.2013 and therefore, no arrear will be payable on account of these orders upto 30.06.2013.


